Gentlemen,

I hope this email finds all of you well. First of all, I wanted to apologize for being difficult when I attended your training back in June. As I'm sure all of you know, . . . . . I was having a hard time dealing with the tremendous stress I have been under. But that still is no excuse to take it out on anyone else. So the primary reason for this email is to thank each and everyone of you. Because of my training I received there, I not only secured one job, I have TWO fantastic jobs. I started at H. . . . . Engineering as a Production Planner and Inventory Analyst. My starting wage is \$60,000 per year with a 10% annual profit sharing bonus. I have my own office with a window AND a door if you can believe it LOL. This is the type of position I had before I was incarcerated, and I didn't think there was a chance in hell I would ever get back there. It's been a struggle and that's putting it mildly. If it were not for my training at Warehouseman Training, I probably would not have been able to secure a weekend job at the new A. . . . . Fulfillment Center in O'Fallon which I started August 3rd. So I wanted to reach out and thank you so much. You guys do a great job there. I will be forever grateful. Best to you all.

## 2019 A Productive Year

In the current year we graduated over 100 students between the *Certificated Warehouseman & Administrative Assistant* programs. WTI also partnered with Department of Workforce Development, Department of Corrections and Full Employment Council to create "**Project 30**" to assist ex-offenders with all available resources to either find direct hire positions or to place Graduates with employers that have job openings that will lead to permanent living wage job with as little red tape as possible. We graduated 27 out of 30 over the 6 month period with 91% employed.

Our **TRACE** program for out-of-district students had the most productive year yet. We brought to the Kansas City area over 25 students for both programs. In the coming year we should be able to increase that number dramatically.

Employment rates were way over the WIOA and SkillUp guidelines this year. With unemployment so low employers are looking at *skills over experience* within these fields.

## WTI 14th Anniversary

Since August 2006 WTI has been providing an environment where those in need of skills sets can learn those skills to obtain a living wage job. It has been a terrific 14 years and we hope to have another great 14 years, The *Certificated Warehouseman* program teaches specific skills and knowledge to operate a Power Industrial Truck within the OSHA guidelines in a warehouse environment. The *Administrative Assistant* class allows students to get hands on training in Office 365 (Word, Excel, Outlook) which is a basic requirement in any office setting, along with other office skills we teach. These two programs make the students the number one candidate in the employer's eyes due to what they have learned in these programs. These programs are constantly updated to keep up with the employer's needs.
